



Consultant: Climate Change Policy

In April 2021, Education International launched its *Teach for the Planet Campaign*, calling on governments to guarantee quality climate change education for all. We are now looking for a consultant who could support the policy and advocacy components of the campaign.

Services to be provided

- Support policy monitoring, analysis and development related to climate change education;
- Contribute to internal reviews of externally produced climate-related policy research, as commissioned by EI;
- Provide advice on and support the implementation of EI's climate advocacy strategy;
- Provide expertise and policy input to support the communications and outreach dimensions of the campaign;
- Provide advice on climate advocacy capacity-building for EI members;
- Provide support as required to EI's climate network made up of climate activists within our member organisations.

Duration

The consultancy services will be provided full-time, during CEST normal office hours, for a period of 3 months, from Tuesday 15th June until Tuesday 15th September 2021.

Profile

- Demonstrated experience of working directly on issues related to climate change and environmental policy;
- Knowledge of intergovernmental processes on climate change, including the COP;
- Prior experience of engaging with civil society actors and networks in the climate field;
- Skilled in collaborating with teammates and external partners in a multicultural environment;
- Ability to work in English, with very good written and oral communication skills;
- Able to grasp complex information and present it to diverse audiences in an accessible fashion.
